

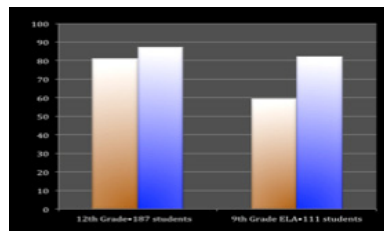
# audiojack
